With a new, larger venue, incorporating several blocks of downtown Hyattsville, "*Arts & Ales*" will take place on Saturday, September 10th, 2016, from 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm on the 4300 Blocks of Gallatin and Farragut Streets, Hyattsville, MD 20781. The juried festival will feature over 120 exhibiting artists and artisans, 20 craft breweries, 10 food vendors, as well as 6 mainstage performances. The event is free and family-friendly. Tasting passes (ages 21+) are \$30 in advance online and can also be purchased for \$35 at the gate.

<u>Directions and parking</u> are also available online: Park for free in designated lots, including the Justice Center Underground Garage at <u>5000 Rhode Island Avenue</u>, <u>Hyattsville</u>, <u>MD 20781</u>. Additional parking options listed online; look for signs.
