Starting in January 2013, with the support of County Councilmember Will Campos and the Gateway Arts District Management Team, Hyattsville Community Development Corporation (CDC) will begin the street art program that will run until June 2013.

Participating property owners will work with a selected artist from our pool of street artists to craft an artwork that will visually resonate with our community's many voices.



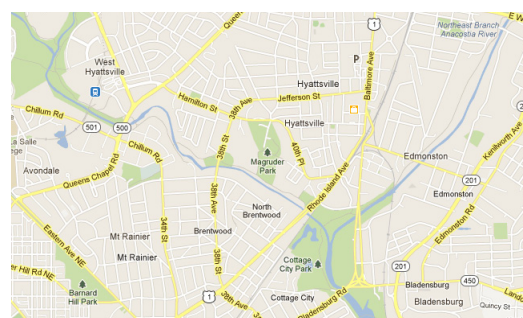
